Perashat Bereshit

Perasha:	Genesis 1:1 – 6:8	(Page 2)
Haftarah:	Isaiah 42:5 – 43:10	(Page 21)

This week's Perasha is the very first Perasha in the Torah. We read the story of the creation of the world. There are many firsts in this Perasha: the creation of the first man and woman, the first sin (*Adam and Eve's eating from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil*), and the first murder (*Cain murdering his brother Abel*).

The first verse of the Haftarah connects the reading to the theme of the Perasha. "G-d who creates the heavens..." However, Isaiah's prophecy is not recounting the past; instead, it describes creation as an ongoing phenomenon and process.

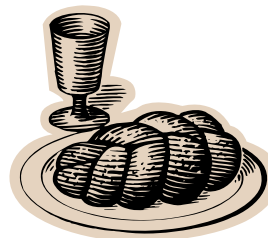
