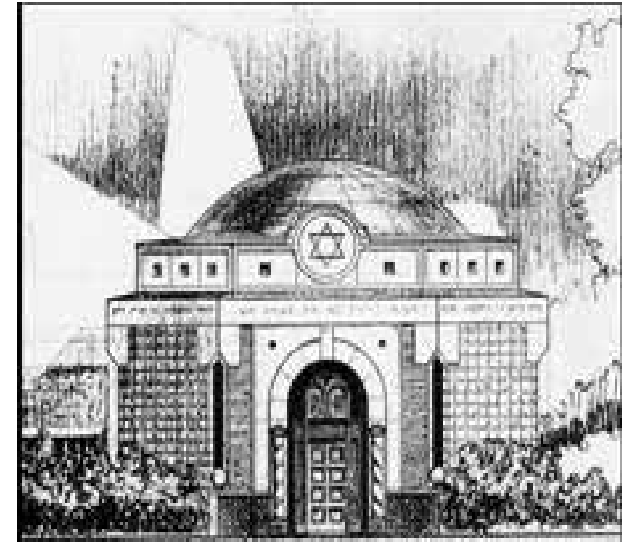

## Shabbat Perashat Vayetze

Perasha:	Genesis 28:10-32:3	(Page 106)
Haftarah:	Hosea 12:13-14:10	(Page 118)

In this week's Perasha, on his way to Haran, Jacob experiences the famed prophecy of "Jacob's Ladder". Once in Haran, he meets Rachel, and contracts with Laban for her hand in marriage. Laban switches Leah for Rachel forcing Jacob to negotiate another seven years of service for Rachel. Between his two wives and their hand maids, Jacob fathers eleven sons. Jacob approaches Laban to negotiate a proper salary for continued service. Jacob uses his vast knowledge of nature and husbandry to amass a fortune in sheep and cattle. After six years he decides with Rachel and Leah to flee from Laban. G-d intervenes and Jacob, while confronting Laban for his years of duplicity, unwittingly curses Rachel.

This concluding portion of the book of Hosea begins with reference to Jacob's journey to Haran to find and work on behalf of a wife, hence its obvious connection to the Perasha. The prophet points out to the People of Israel their humble origins, in an attempt to put things in perspective and restore their faith and reliance upon G-d.
