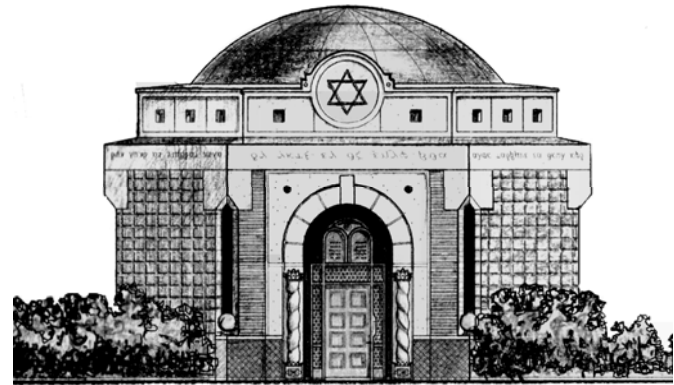


The OVS AED (automated external defibrillator) is

## Perashat Haazinu

Perasha:	Deuteronomy 32:1-52	(page 896)
Haftarah:	Hosea 14:2-10 & Joel 2:15-27	(page 891)

Moses began his ministry at the Red Sea with a song of praise and triumph. It is only fitting that he will end his life of service to G-d and the People with another hymn of joy on the banks of the Jordan. Moses recounts Israel’s history and points out all the lessons to learn from it. The result is a vindication of the ways of G-d and his relations to Israel.

This Shabbat is known as Shabbat TeShuva - the Shabbat of Return - because the Haftarah begins with the words, "Shuva (return) Israel to G-d" gleaned from both Hosea and Joel. The prophets describe G-d's desire to forgive His children, if only they will repent. The fast of Yom Kippur is mentioned as well as the rewards awaiting us if we proclaim G-d in our midst. The passage from Joel gives us a Shofar connection to Teshuva.
