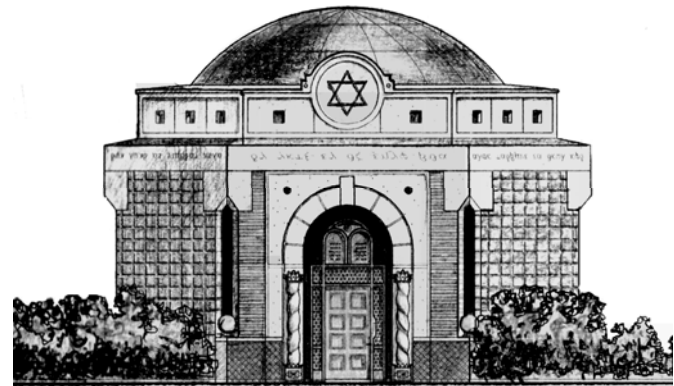

## Shabbat Perashat Ki Tavo

Perasha:	Deuteronomy	26:1-29:8	(page 859)
Haftarah:	Isaiah	60:1-22	(page 874)

During the 40 years in the desert, the Jews were being prepared to accept the reality of G-d's mastery and the responsibility of keeping His Mitzvot. Now, they are poised to cross the Jordan and assume their intended place as "... highest of all the nations on earth." Moses commanded a number of declarations and ceremonies. These ceremonies would underscore the cause and effect relationship that exists between adherence to Torah, the laws of nature, and the divine responsiveness of the land. The Perasha concludes with the beginning of Moses' final discourse. He starts by recounting the miraculous nature of the past 40 years and its clear indication of G-d's ever present protection, past and future.

The uplifting message of the Haftarah is the coming of the Geula, when G-d will restore His people to the land and the nations and peoples of the world will flock to Jerusalem to pay homage to G-d and His people.
