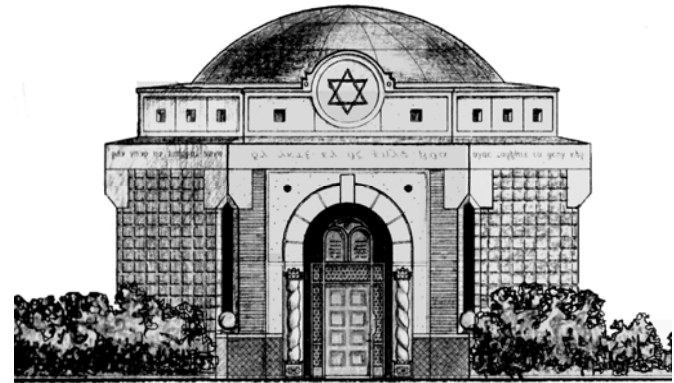

Shabbat Perashat Toledot

Perasha:	Genesis 25:19-28:9	(Page 93)
Haftarah:	Malachi 1:1-2:7	(Page 102)

In this week's Perasha, we are introduced to Isaac and Rebecca's sons: Esau and Jacob. As they grew, the boys each developed a different personality – Esau is the hunter and outdoorsman; Jacob, the mild, studious tent-dweller. The Perasha details the duplicity of Jacob and Rebecca in fooling Isaac. Isaac blesses Jacob with spiritual and material gain, after which Esau returns to discover Jacob's plot. He receives his own blessing for material gain, and is determined to kill Jacob. Rebecca, fearful for Jacob's life, convinces Isaac to send Jacob to her brother Laban in search of a wife. Isaac confirms on Jacob the future of the Jewish nation before his departure to Laban. Jacob departs for Padan Aram, and Esau marries the daughter of Ishmael.

Malachi brings G-d's message to the people that He loves Jacob (and his descendants), and He hates Esau, even though Jacob and Esau are brothers. Thus, the Haftarah echoes the rivalry and relationship between the two brothers that is the substance of the Perashat. The Haftarah refers to the respect a son has for his father. In this regard, Esau was exemplary.
