Chatan Torah	Person called up on Simchat Torah to conclude reading of the Five Books of Moses
Etz Haim	Holding Torah while it's being undressed & dressed
Gelilah	Undressing & dressing Torah
Haftarah	Reading from Books of Prophets (Kaddish & Memorial Prayers can be said)
Hakamah	Lifting Torah to be shown to Congregation
Ma'im Kohanim	Hand washing for Kohanim
Mashlim	Next to last person called to Torah (Kaddish & Memorial Prayers are said)
Ner Tamid	Lighting perpetual lamp following Neila
Nerot Kippur	Lighting candles prior to Kal Nidre service
Peticha	Opening and/or Closing Ark
Peticha Et Sha'are	Open Ark for Congregation Blessing of prosperity for the New Year
Rimmonim	Placing bells on Torah
Sefer Kal Nidra through Asiri	Holding a Torah during Kal Nidre (10 Torahs)
Sefer Rishon	Carrying 1st Torah
Sefer Sheni	Carrying 2nd Torah
Segan	Standing by Rabbi/Reader during services
Yiimloch Adonai	Song announcing the return of Torahs to Ark
