SECURITY FEE: A security fee of \$205 per single and associate membership account, \$310 per family membership and \$257.50 per family ages 90 and over account will be assessed annually.

BUILDING FUND: A Building Fund Contribution totaling \$1000 per single membership account (and families under age 35 at time of joining) / \$2000 per family membership account over age 35 is traditionally paid beginning in a member's second year through their 6th year of membership at a rate of \$200 per year / \$400 per year respectively.

Newlyweds married by Rabbi Hearshen, or people who completed their conversion with Rabbi Hearshen, in the past year, will be eligible for a 50% discount for their first year of membership.

Synagogue Dues and Building Fund may be paid annually, quarterly or monthly. We accept MasterCard, VISA, Discover and American Express, as well as personal checks. Payments via credit card carry a 2.7% convenience fee. Payments via ACH (online) or check are at no cost. Congregation Or VeShalom policy states that a member must have paid 50% of their annual Dues and Building Fund by July 1st to receive their *Member High Holy Day* tickets and member parking privileges.

Affiliation with Congregation Or VeShalom will never be denied due to an inability to pay full dues. We require completion of a confidential application for dues adjustment which will be reviewed by our Finance Committee.
